MEMBER IN THE SPOTLIGHT: JIM DANIELS



Jim Daniels was born in Diss, Norfolk, England and immigrated with his family to the USA in 1957 aboard the Queen Mary at the tender age of 10. Jim's dad was a village policeman in the UK and they lived close to a U.S. Air force Base where they got to know many Americans. The stories of warm weather and visions of orange trees apparently persuaded his parents to make the move. Jim and his family relocated to Dade City by train where his dad eventually found a job in Tampa. After some training the company moved him to Lake-

land in 1957. After Jim graduated from Kathleen High School in 1963, he returned to England to live with his grandparents. He enjoyed an active but enjoyable schedule during this time period which included factory work, art school night classes, traveling, and popular Beatle mania diversions. After returning to the USA, he attended Florida Southern and became a U.S. Citizen in preparation for entry into the Army as a Second Lieutenant. Upon graduation in 1968, he went on active duty and eventually served in Vietnam. After leaving the Army life, Jim felt it was time to do some traveling so he bought a motorcycle and traveled 15,000 miles through 33 states, Canada and Mexico. Now that's a bike ride! Upon returning to Florida he met his present wife, lantha, and finally settled down. After 35 years of marriage, Jim is happy to say that he has 3 children and 8 grandchildren. After his kids started school, his wife went to work with the Polk County Sheriff's Dept. and just recently retired after 28 years of service. Jim has spent most of his career with U.S. Foodservice and retired in 1999. Outside interests include golf, exercise, home projects, travel and grandkids. Jim first found out about the CPA program through an article in the paper. His favorite classes were the firing range, K-9 Unit and the police helicopter. Jim is a volunteer with the Citizen's Assisted Patrol unit in his neighborhood and is currently being trained to be a peer advocate for new amputees in the Lakeland area. We're certainly happy to have Jim in the CPAAA and we look forward to his participation and input as we continue to grow.

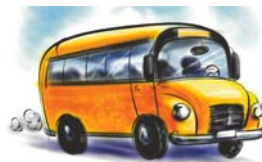
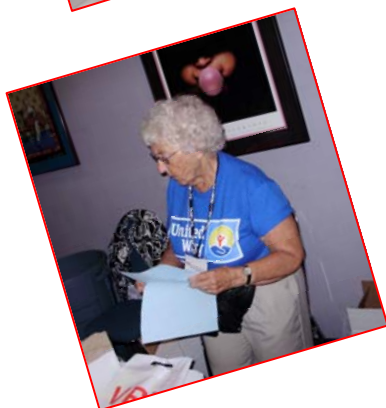


Back to School Blast

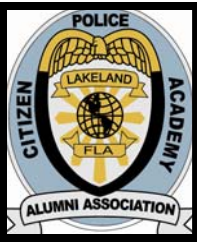
