Statement from Chief Lisa Womack:



Given recent media stories about the Lakeland Police Department, I want to assure the citizens of the City of Lakeland that we take every allegation seriously and we are committed to your safety and the quality of life in Lakeland. We have a thorough process for investigating complaints of misconduct and we will investigate these and any other allegations we receive, swiftly and completely. This department does not condone the alleged actions as have been reported in recent days and any officer proven to be involved in this type behavior will be dealt with accordingly, including possible termination.

Full disclosure of findings will be made upon completion of our administrative investigation. The Lakeland Police Department is a professional police department with quality officers dedicated to keeping our community safe.

CALEA Onsite Assessment Report:

The Lakeland Police Department has received a copy of the report filed by the Assessors following the onsite in April. The report received is the Assessors findings from the onsite. It will now be forwarded... to the full CALEA Commission for review. Chief Womack said "I am pleased with the report and findings and believe it reflects all the hard work during the last year and a half working up to this point." She went on to say, "The men and women of this department are dedicated to their jobs and are committed to delivering quality service to our community. Being awarded our accreditation will be the payoff they deserve for all of their hard work." The Commission will review the report and a hearing will be held at an upcoming conference. At the conclusion of their review and the hearing, the Commission will make the final determination as to the status of the Lakeland Police Department's quest for accreditation.
